TAE for 2023 for Purse Seine VDS

f. (ii) PS VDS TAEs (VDST-SC11 Outcomes)

37. The PNAO VDS Manager presented *WP.6 (ii) PS VDS TAEs for 2023 – 2025* to provide the outcome of the TAE discussion that took place at the 11th VDST-SC meeting.

38. Discussions included:

- The importance of considering what scenarios could affect the factors that might enable a change in allocation of TAE for PNA that should be considered as a potential risk and/or opportunity.
- This concern could be taken up in the discussions in the SWG on VDS Risks and Opportunities.
- The figures of the TAEs have not changed and such should be considered for future years and the potential implications it would have on PAEs.
- The level of the TAE is related to the skipjack TRP.

Outcomes

39. PA27 agreed:

- a. That there is no need to change their decision at PA17 to apply a PNA TAE based on 2010 effort level specified as 44,033 days in CMM2021-01.**
- b. To adopt the 2023 PNA TAE, the provisional PNA TAE for 2024 and 2025, the 2023 VDS TAE and the provisional VDS TAE for 2024 and 2025 as set out in the table below.**
